Title (of the Motion)	For a true status of autonomy for Corsica

## Considering:

- a) That the Corsican people have been engaged in a legitimate struggle for the recognition of their rights for over fifty years;
- b) That since 2015, in every territorial election, the Corsican people have expressed a very large majority in favor of a true status for Corsica;
- c) That, however, the legitimate demands expressed by the Corsicans in seeking dialogue with the State have remained unfulfilled;
- d) The political process known as "Bauveau," initiated following the assassination of Yvan Colonna, involving the Executive Council, the groups of the Corsican Assembly, parliamentarians, mayors, and the political and active forces of the island, aimed at developing a comprehensive political solution for Corsica and its people, centered around a status of legislative autonomy;
- e) The deliberation No. 23/089 of the Corsican Assembly dated July 5, 2023, titled AUTONOMIA, which establishes clear proposals for a legislative autonomy status, drawing particularly from the statutes of neighboring Mediterranean islands and that of the Azores;
- f) The political agreement reached among a large majority of Corsican elected officials on February 24, 2024, titled "Solemn Declaration of February 23, 2024";
- g) The political agreement reached on March 11, 2024, between the Minister of the Interior, Gerald Darmanin, on behalf of the President of the Republic, the Government, and the State, on one hand, and the representatives of Corsican elected officials, on the other, regarding constitutional writings establishing a statutory evolution towards legislative autonomy;
- h) The deliberation No. 24/030 of the Corsican Assembly concerning the project of constitutional writings within the framework of the constitutional revision dedicated to Corsica, dated March 28, 2024;
- i) The commitment of the President of the Republic and the Government to continue the constitutional revision during the year 2025.



## The European Free Alliance:

- Reaffirms the right of peoples to self-determination and defends the universal values of democracy;
- Reminds that Corsica is the only European island territory that does not benefit from an autonomy status;
- Supports the Corsican people's right to autonomy;
- Supports the elected officials of Corsica in their desire to bring this process to fruition;
- Calls for a comprehensive political solution for Corsica;
- Recalls that only the modification of European treaties granting regions a true institutional status will strengthen the economic, social, and territorial cohesion of the European Union.
