Motion: Islamic Radicalism and Violence

A. Having regard to the wave of attacks that take place both in Europe and in other parts of the world,

The European Free Alliance,

- 1. Strongly condemns all acts of violence and expresses its sympathy and its absolute rejection of brutal attacks such as those recently perpetrated in Paris and Copenhagen.
- 2. Condemns the use of "the war against terrorism" to curtail rights and freedoms, to foster violent responses and to instigate hatred.
- 3. Condemns the confusion made, sometimes willingly, between Muslim religion and violent Islamic extremism and radicalism.
- 4. Condemns the social apartheid, the pockets of poverty that create greater inequalities in our societies.
- 5. Condemns the use of cooperation against terrorism to the detriment of a "shared cooperation and development".
- 6. Asks for transparency in the financing of all places of religious worship.
- 7. Considers freedom of the press as one of the pillars of democracy.
- 8. Advocates responsibility and respect as the basis for freedom of speech.
- 9. Advocates tolerance and dialogue as tools for the resolution of conflicts
- 10. Believes that cultural and ideological differences enrich the society we all share.
- 11. Considers that the key lies in education, in respect and appreciation of diversity, and in culture, rising awareness and conveying the unavoidable changes that our Society needs.
